- Build my confidence and take charge of my life.
- Stand up for me when I need it.
- Put limits in place that keep me on track.

Share power: Treat me with respect and give me a say.

- Take me seriously and treat me fairly.
- Involve me in decisions that affect me.
- Work with me to solve problems and reach goals.
- Create opportunities for me to take action and lead.

Expand possibilities: Connect me with people and places that broaden my world.

- Inspire me to see possibilities for my future.
- Expose me to new ideas, experiences, and places.
- Introduce me to people who can help me grow.
